

CHLORAMPHENICOL

Antibiotics

Recommended treatment of:

infections caused by different types of bacteria, such as typhoid fever and salmonellosis (Salmonella typhi); bacterial meningitis (Haemophilus influenzae, Neisseria meningitidis), an acute infectious disease characterized by inflammation of the meninges; rickettsiosi (Rickettsia); brucellosis (Brucella); psittacosis (Chlamydophila psittaci), an infectious disease transmitted from birds to humans; lymphogranuloma venereum (Lymphogranuloma-psittacosis) sexually transmitted disease; urinary tract infections due to Gram-negative bacteria; infection due to anaerobic bacteria (Grampositive cocci, Clostridium).

Active principle:

Chloramphenicol Sodium Succinate

1g / 10ml powder - Box of 1 vial with powder and 1 ampoule with solvent
